AIF Growth Accelerates

SME IPOs soared 40% month-on-month in August, reaching ₹843 crore, while mainboard IPO fundraising slowed sharply - retail investors drove the SME market, whereas QIBs dominated larger listings.

According to Kresha Gupta, Director & Fund Manager at Steptrade Capital, HNI allocations to alternatives have risen to 20–30% and are expected to reach 35–40% in the coming decade marking a clear shift toward alternatives as core holdings.
